TB TEST NO LONGER REQUIRED FOR VOLUNTEERS

The Board of Education has determined that volunteers will no longer be required to obtain a TB clearance. This requirement was removed from Board Policy 1240. Ed Code does not require volunteers obtain a TB clearance and the Board has approved removing this requirement from our volunteer process. Volunteers will still need to be fingerprinted. Please stop by the school office to obtain a fingerprinting form before going to the District Office to be fingerprinted.

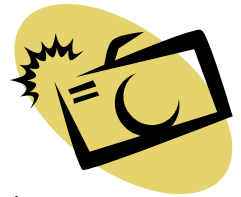
DISCOVERY CLUB HAS OPENINGS
