GALLERY WALK

The goal of this Gallery Walk is to begin to look past the surface, beyond your initial judgments of each other, and to start to get to know your classmates. You will do so by spending some time observing each other's "Know Thyself" projects.

In an orderly fashion, when I tell you to begin, you will move around the room, spending two minutes at each project. By the end of the two minutes, you will need to have recorded on your paper many of the interesting things that you learned about your classmate's identity.

RULES

1. Before we begin the Gallery Walk, we will write down our initial judgments about our classmate's character. These will be written down under each student's name in the "Judgments" section. You can write one-word responses or a complete sentence (i.e. Happy, You like the color green, Stylish, etc.). There should be no putdowns in this section or else you will not receive credit for the assignment.
2. This is an individual assignment; you are not working with a partner.
3. There is no talking during the Gallery Walk. This will allow you to really think about what you are observing.
