IV. Unfinished Business:

A. School Update: All but 51 students returned to in person school. Kids are doing a great job of physical distancing and wearing masks.

B. Preparing for next year. Adding a teaching position. 4 combos next year. Modernization plans are underway. 6-8 months to approve from state.

C. Election Updates: We have 50 completed as of yet, SSC election.

D. Surveys: District and Site (SAEBRS)- Closed last week.

F. Summer learning: Options are being shared by Mr. Barge. Website has summer learning ideas.

V. New Business: Agenda Items

- A. SPAC Report-** Presented by Ben: High school graduations will be taking place in person. Community in Parks and Rec. district. High school start times will be changing next year. 20-21 school year- in person, full time, 5 days a week. No major changes before end of school year. There will be a voluntary option for distance learners- this may be contracted out, a business that specializes in distance learning. Private school attendees can reenroll to district. This is different from open enrollment. Covid testing continues and process is continuing to be refined.
- B. SEL Curriculum:** Presented by Melissa: Social Emotional Curriculum, SEL, gives strategies that focus on self-regulation, sensory processing, executive functioning skills, think about how you think and the way you feel. This is a structured curriculum for all ages, and abilities. (Zones of Regulation) The book is \$55. There are ½ day or full day webinars. This gives tools on how to use curriculum. The book has 18 lessons, with two, 20-minute sessions over a 5 month period. Gives student choice. Lesson on expected or unexpected behavior.
- C. Next year enrollment and staffing:** 500-520 students. We will have another teaching position open. We have 4 combo classes next year. 2 grades at every grade level. Covid relief money makes flexibility of staffing. We do not want to be understaffed, we can be overstaffed next year, due to Covid monies. We may add an intervention teacher for next year. We will get an instructional assistant TK-2 to be funded by state/feds. \$100,000 due to our school size, we want to spend it on helpful tools for students. Leadership is discussing.
- D. Proposed SPSA Actions for 2021-22:** 4 goals this year: school connectedness, building Healthy Environment for social/emotional growth, Engaging Academic Programs, and Clear Pathways to Bright Futures.
- E. Proposed Budget 2021-22:** \$28,850.00 has been earmarked to spend, we have \$2,650.00 remaining to be spent. Costs for next year: Implement virtual assemblies- anti bullying. Purchases for social/ emotional for students. Purchase SEL book for staff book study. Academics, ELD, On-line curriculum to support student learning, intervention, science consumables, Lexi Core 5 (TK-2) interventions has been extended through 2024, district is paying for Swun math materials next year, iReady is purchased by district for next year. Proposed budget will be sent out later this week.
