VI. Public Comments/Questions Joanne McConiga, SPAC rep. At the Superintendent's Parent Advisory Committee meeting, the District says they are projecting a \$5 million budget shortfall, mostly due to an ongoing grant of \$4.2 million now becoming a one-time fund. There is also \$2.29 million cost of living decrease in the funding to the District. A new state law requires high schools to start at 8:30 or later and middle schools to begin no earlier than 8:00 am beginning July 2022. No further time adjustments are planned at the HS and MS levels for now.
