Here are important reminders for the end of the year.

- If you know your child will be absent on the last day of school (June 11), please let us know by calling the attendance line at (916) 867-2054, option 1. Remember, June 12 is the last day to clear absences.
- All library books are due. Please either return your books or send payment for the lost book(s).
- If you owe money to the cafeteria, please send in payment. If you need to check your balance, call the cafeteria at (916) 867-2749. During the last weeks of school both the breakfast and lunch menus are subject to change. On June 11, the last day of school, only breakfast will be served- no lunch.
- If your child has medication stored in the school office, parents will need to pick it up by Wednesday, June 12. We cannot store medication over the summer months. Thank you! ☀
