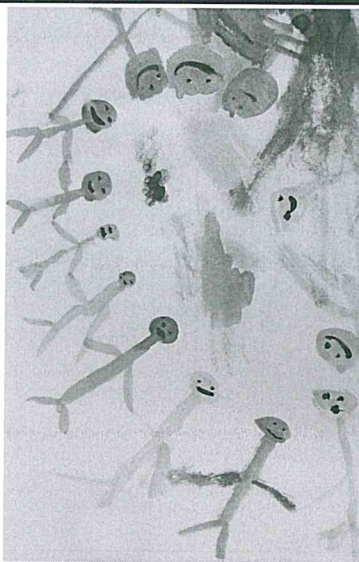

Dear Mariposa Families,

This fall has gotten off to a great start at school. There are many new faces at Mariposa, both students and staff and we are very happy to have them all at Mariposa!

Your Mariposa staff has been learning about Restorative Circles and Restorative Practices this year. Your student may have come home and told you about their circles or morning meeting in class. The goal of a daily class meeting is to allow all students to have a voice and to provide all students with a way to communicate with their peers and their instructors. All of this work is done to build strong classroom and school communities where students can increase their feelings of safety and belonging on campus. The meetings usually start with a question that everyone can answer and then time is given to each participant to say what they are thinking or feeling about the circle topic that day. Ask your student to help you have a circle at home to experience it.
