While reviewing your fable, please check off each item once it has been **REVISED** on your rough draft.

I. Quick Check

- Fable includes **a Title** that relates to the story and is **Capitalized**
- Each paragraph is **Indented**
- The fable is long enough to be a 1/2 page – a full page in length, typed, double-spaced.

II. Setting

- Fable begins with a description of the **Setting**.
- Awesome Adjectives** are used to describe the surroundings in vivid details throughout the fable.

III. Characters

- Characters are either animals or inanimate objects that are given human characteristics.
- Awesome Adjectives** are used to describe the characters in vivid details throughout the fable. Fable "shows" your animals' characteristics, not just "tells."
- Vivid Verbs** are used to describe character actions.

IV. Conflict

- Only **one** conflict is present in the fable and it is easy to understand.
- Conflict has a **Resolution** by the end of the fable.

V. Moral

- Moral is clearly stated at the end of your fable.
- Moral relates directly to the events of your fable.

V. Mechanics

- All words that you believe are misspelled have been highlighted on your draft.
