## TRUANCY COURT SUMMARY

Welfare & Institutions Code section 601(b); Education Code section 48293

### WHERE:

- Juvenile Courthouse, 9605 Kiefer Boulevard, Sacramento

### COURT CRITERIA:

- Tardy or absent from class 30 minutes without valid excuse five (5) or more times in one school year; or
- Absent from one or more classes on a day without valid excuse five (5) or more times in one school year

Education Code sections 48260, 48262, 48263, 48264.5, 48291, 48292  
Welfare and Institutions Code section 601(b)

### COURT ORDERS FOR STUDENT:

- Declared ward of the court until age 21
- Attend a school approved by the Court
- 20 to 40 hours community service
- Fine of \$100.00
- Attend Truancy Prevention Program
- Suspend privilege to drive an automobile until age 17 or for 1 year, whichever is longer
- Five (5) days in juvenile hall for contempt of court if student disobeys the court's orders

### COURT ORDERS FOR PARENT:

- Limit parents' rights over the student by:
  - declaring child a ward of the court
  - suspending the parents right to make educational decisions
- Fine of \$100.00 (first offense); \$250.00 (second offense); \$500.00 (third offense)
- Post a \$200.00 bond to be forfeited if the child continues truancy
- Parent must personally take the child to school daily
- File proof of child's enrollment with the court
- Complete Parent Education and Counseling Program
- Five (5) days in jail and a \$1,000.00 fine for contempt of court if parent disobeys the court's orders
