

SHIRTS

- *Must have straps
- *No exposed undergarments
- *No low-cut tops
- *No tube tops or strapless tops
- *No crop tops or bare midriffs
- *No see-through fabric

NOT ACCEPTABLE



PANTS

- *No exposed undergarments
- *No sagging pants
- *No chains or spikes
- *No bandanas – on heads or in pockets

NOT ACCEPTABLE



SKIRTS/SHORTS

- *Skirts and shorts must be fist length

NOT ACCEPTABLE



NO PAJAMAS or SLIPPERS

- *No sleepwear or pajama-like pants
- *No slippers or house shoes

DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

The major responsibility for dress and grooming is placed upon the student and the student's guardians. Inappropriately dressed students will be expected to change clothing. Multiple infractions will result in progressive discipline. The following guidelines shall apply to all regular school activities.

- All garments must fit and be worn in the manner in which they are designed. Pants must be worn at or above the hip point with the ability to stay up without a belt. Pajama pants are not appropriate.
- Footwear must be worn at all times. No house shoes or slippers.
- Tops shall be sufficient to conceal undergarments at all times. Tube tops, off-the-shoulder, low cut, crop tops, strapless tops, and bare midriffs are not allowed.
- Overly short shorts and skirts are prohibited – fist length is a good rule of thumb.
- Clothing and accessories shall be free of writing, pictures, logos, patches, or any other insignia which are crude, violent, vulgar, profane, sexually suggestive or display images that are considered by school officials or law enforcement to denote gang, cult, racist, or satanic affiliation.
- Hats and hoods in classrooms are at each teacher's discretion. Dew rags and bandanas are not allowed on school campus.
