Must earn Cs or higher

- A** History/Social Science - 2 years
- B** English - 4 years
- C** Mathematics - 3 years complete through IM 3  
( 4 years strongly recommended)
- D** Lab Science - 2 years  
(3 years strongly recommended)
- E** Language Other Than English (LOTE) - 2 years same language
- F** Visual and Performing Art (VAPA) - 1 year
- G** Academic Elective - 1 year

# SAT/ACT

- \* Students should take the SAT and/or the ACT for the first time spring junior year.
- \* SAT tests May 2 (deadline to register April 3) & June 6 (deadline to register May 8). Register on line at [www.collegeboard.org](http://www.collegeboard.org)
  - \* Use your PSAT scores to help you prepare for the SAT by reviewing your answers & accessing Khan Academy.

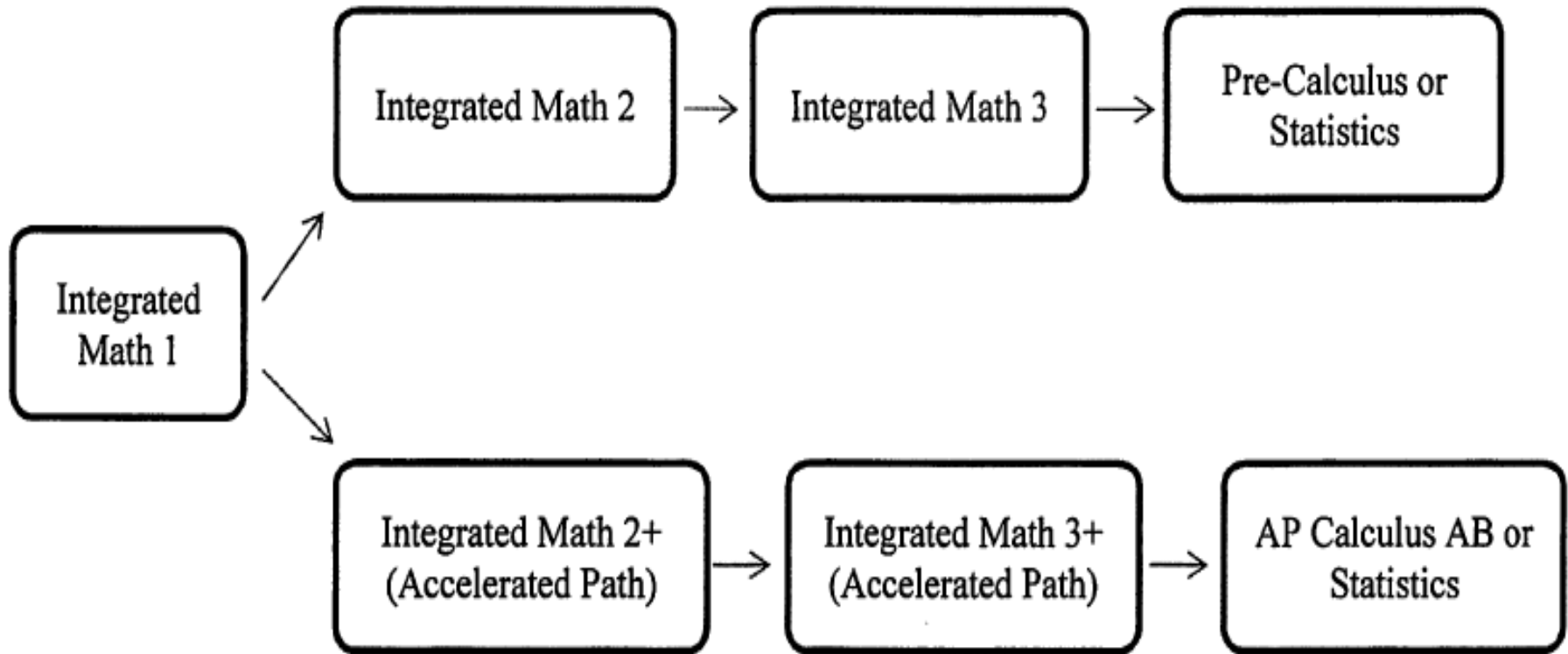
