(3 years strongly recommended)
- E** Language Other Than English (LOTE) - 2 years same language
- F** Visual and Performing Art (VAPA) - 1 year
- G** Academic Elective - 1 year

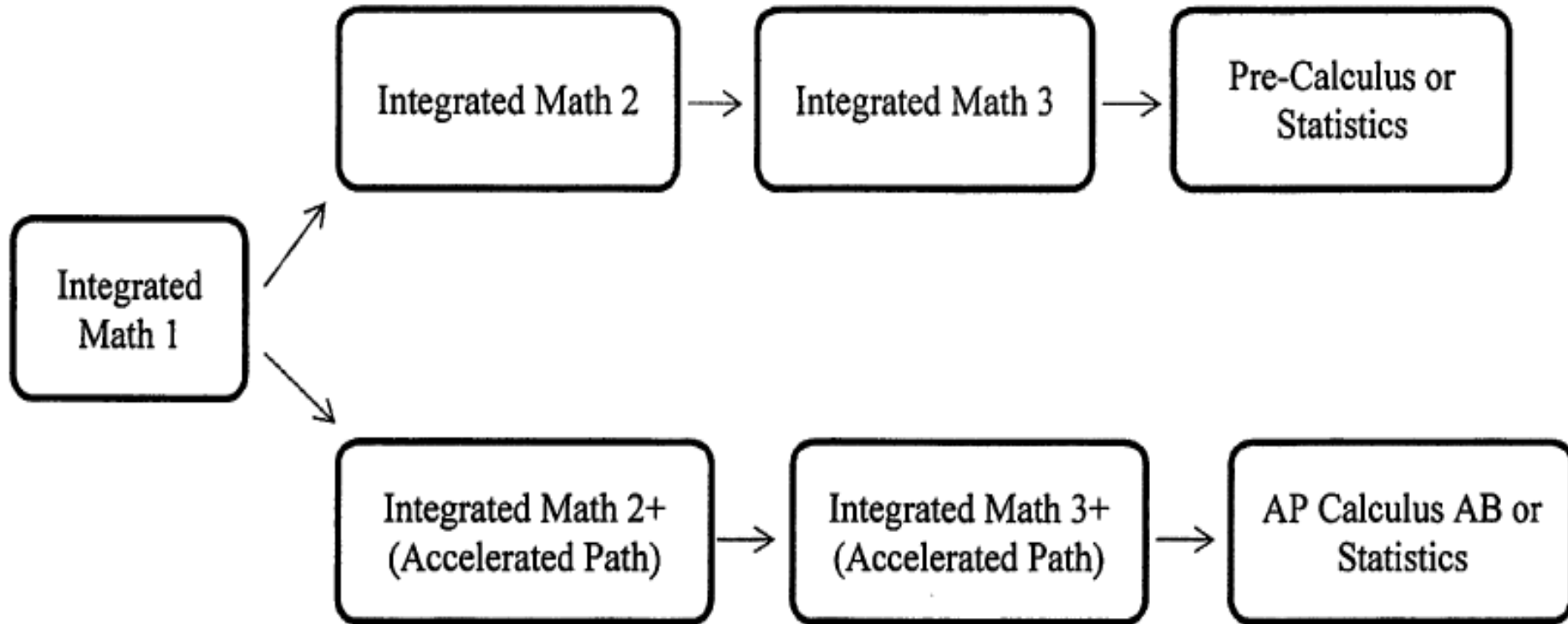
