- Incoming 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade student who is credit deficient and not on track to graduate and/or who has failed a core class
- Incoming 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade student who is D-remediation for A-G eligibility
- Current 12<sup>th</sup> grade student who is credit deficient and not on track to graduate
- Incoming 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade student who needs to take a core class to maintain eligibility for enrollment in a specialized program in the fall. **No incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade student eligible.**
