Clarification:

Students are only assessed on grade level standards. The questions become more or less rigorous based on the student's answers & performance, but the questions are from grade-level standards only. Therefore, for example, if a 3rd grader received a 2610 on his ELA exam, this does NOT mean that he exceeded grade level standards in 4th and 5th grade too. The child was only assessed on 3rd grade standards and his score is only reflective of his performance at his current grade level.
