

DREAM Meeting Minutes

September 18, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in Room 18

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m.

2. Reports

- Minutes from last meeting

Kristina moved that the minutes from the 8/29/18 be approved as written. Tracy seconded the motion. Vote taken-motion carried.

- Art

Mrs. Weil reported that the fish project will be installed in the MP Room to look like an underwater scene in time for the International Celebration. She has been working collaboratively with students individually and in groups learning lines and patterns.

- Band

Brittany reported that Band and Recorder are progressing nicely. Instrument repairs are even less than reported in August. First-Third grade Music is going well. Howe Ave. Elementary is donating a music stand rack to us and Tim's Music will repair our broken music stands. Do not have an estimate for that yet. Capitol Pops wants to come to Deterding- free concert. The Board asked for clarification from Brittany regarding enrichment vs. supplies for budget purposes. The Board also asked how many recorders were purchased (120) and the cost per recorder (\$4.95). Brittany said she has approximately 25 left.

- George

The children love the song they will be singing at the International Celebration. 5/6 Idol Night is October 18th. Evening with the Stars is only 1 ½ weeks away and the choir is working hard in rehearsals.

- Dance

Kdg.through first grades are working on stretching, warming up, tempos and cardio. Third and fourth are working on folk dancing and cardio.

- Faculty

Rebecca thanked parents for their donations to the Penny Wars. It was a huge success. She encouraged everyone to attend the International Celebration and Book Fair on Wed., buy a SaveAround coupon book from a 4th grade student. She reminded us that field trips are starting and all parents need to sign in and wear a badge when on campus between 8:00 a.m. and 2:35 p.m. She will discuss

- Principal

Melanie reported that we had our first School Site Council meeting today. She said we have a lot of new Council members. They voted to approve the budget for the year. Mrs. Allen let them know that DREAM money this year will buy approximately 50 chromebooks for Deterding.

- Treasurer

Tracy reported that we have \$41,000 in our account as of today. Our projected income for 2018-19 is \$90,000 with expenses of \$70,000 for a net of \$20,000. DREAM has added a line item in this year's budget for Technology. We are on track and on target for the start of the year thanks to the DREAM Run being a huge success. We all thanked Tracy for her hard work. Tracy went over the Harvest Festival breakdown from last year for Erin Harrington, who is co-chairing for this year.

3. Events and Fundraising Plans

- Penny Wars – Update/Results

The top three classes will get a pizza party – Hales, Wassom and Flores.

There was a total of \$4585 collected in classrooms and \$1880 donated online.

Walden's class won for best decorated coin jug and will have an ice cream party

- Book Fair

There will be a teacher preview and luncheon this Friday (9/21). They still need volunteers.

- International Celebration

Marisela reported that 28 parents have signed up to bring food, 7 performers, the Mira Loma Lion is coming and the Scottish Highland Dancers. They have food donations from California Burrito and Little Caesar's has donated 20 pizzas. They received a \$25 Bel Air gift card and 10 certificates for personal pizzas from Dominos. They need more pop-ups and tables. Elizabeth Reynolds' Girl Scout troop will help with set-up.

- Harvest Festival

Aureau Pacheco said she may be able to set up a DJ for the festival. She also shared that Panda Express can provide food for a large number of people (1000).

We would not be able to sell it and they would have to serve. They insist on exclusivity. Erin and Melanie met about what was done for the festival last year.

There is a meeting on Sept. 20th at 7 p.m. for all people interested in

volunteering to help with the festival. Erin asked if Mrs. Weil could make a

backdrop for the photo booth. Kristina shared that there is an app that allows you to take the picture with your phone and sends the picture directly to their email. We discussed putting the menu in the Bridge and have small copies to hand out so when people buy the wristbands, they know how much they need to buy food. There will also be a cake walk and bake sale.

Tracy asked George how much it is to rent Fair Oaks Baptist Church. \$200 to rent it and \$100 in gift cards for the people doing the lights, sound, etc.
