

Meraki is an independent study high school that focuses on college and career readiness, while growing self-starters, independent thinkers and responsible young adults. We offer a blended approach to learning which includes small group and/or individual learning, interest-based projects and, if chosen, online courses. Students are assigned to a small advisory group and are paired with an advisor who will co-create and support their learning each year.
