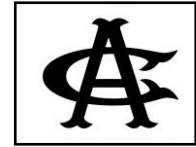

MEETING 2/24/2015 Minutes
For approval at 4/21/2015 SSC Meeting



Minutes
1. Call to Order: Mindy Rhodes called to order the regular meeting of the Andrew Carnegie Middle School Site Council at 2:41 pm on February 24, 2015, in the counselor’s conference room.

3. Additions/Changes to Agenda: None requested
4. Reading and Approval of Minutes of Last Meeting: Approved
5. Student MAP Testing Data: Mr. Siewert discussed midyear review of Carnegie’s Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA). MAP data is used as an indicator of how our students are performing. Mr. Siewert provided handouts showing student performance from Fall 14-15 to Winter 14-15 broken down by sub groups. Learning targets for students based upon SPSA goals. The first part of March is another round of MAP testing. For students that equal or better their score, we are offering a barbeque lunch. Mr. Reeves agreed that food is a good incentive for students. Dave pointed out that this is the second year of MAP testing. We will have Smarter Balanced testing (CASSP) as well. Mr. Siewert discussed Carnegie’s computer lab which is used by Mr. Tulga’s Garage Band class two periods each day and various classes first through fourth period. Twenty-five new computers are needed to replace out of date computers. Based on our percentage of low SES students LCAP funds could be used for a portion of the cost. Our proposal for use of funds is \$10,000 from Local Control Funding, Carnegie PTSA donation of \$7,000 or more, and the remainder covered yearly using a three year lease agreement, or site funds, depending on the final cost. LCAP funding could also be well spent in professional development for teachers to learn how best to meet the needs of students.
6. Liaison, Committee Reports, Student Council Reports: Kaitlyn Smith and Kristi Vivaldi reported 3,500 cans were collected this year, 882 jeans for teens, and 800 valentine lollipops were sold. The students would like to request a field day following the student led conferences.
