  - ii. If you do not have access to a computer – You will have to come to the office after August 3<sup>rd</sup> to use the school computer.

4. Volunteer form

### **SCHEDULE PICK UP PROCESS**

Enter the MULTI PURPOSE Room and find the sign above a table that includes the first letter of your Student’s LAST NAME (for example A-D) to begin the process. Once all your forms have been turned in you will receive the schedule. Anytime during the process, you can purchase additional items listed on the following page.

- Morning & Afternoon Sessions: Last Names Starting with . . .
  - A – G Anytime between 8:15 am to 9:15 am & anytime between 2:30 pm to 3:30 pm
  - H – M Anytime between 9:30 am to 10:30 am & anytime between 3:45 pm to 4:45 pm
  - N – Z Anytime between 10:45 am – 11:45 am & anytime between 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm
  - All Grades anytime between 6:00 pm to 6:30 pm – If you were not able to make the above time frames.



Side Note: If you are not able to make the above times – the office will be open from 8:00 am to 3:30 pm starting August 4<sup>th</sup>.
