Today Counts/Character Counts!: This book is designed to help begin each day of the program with a meaningful activity, mini-lesson, or discussion that focuses the students' attention on The Six Pillars of Character: Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring, and Citizenship.

Drawing Lab for Mixed-Media Artists: This book is designed to make drawing a pleasurable experience for students. Mark-making is one of our first pleasures as children. Having a foundation of basic drawing skills will help in all creative work.

Team Challenges: This book offers ways to share the concept of creative problem solving with children. Through simple, hands-on activities, students can experiment with building methods, discover new uses for everyday items, try on new personas, and learn to express some unusual ideas as they work toward solving a problem as a team. These activities help to build cooperation, communication, and creativity.

Homework Policy
