- Prospective students must be **accompanied by a parent**
- First check into the **Principal's Office**, sign in and receive a visitor badge, school map, copy of the master schedule, and some potential "classroom highlights."
- Visitors can opt to go on a **brief 15-minute tour** led by student government students and are welcome to visit any classroom of their choosing on a **self-guided tour**.



- Visitors are **welcome throughout the day**—there is not a particular schedule to follow, although it is probably best to come at the beginning of a class period, and not too close to lunch (lunch time is from 11:27-11:57 on Thursday, and 12:15-12:45 on Friday) or the end of the day (school ends at 1:41 on Thursday and 2:53 on Friday).
- The Principal's Secretary will provide "**Verification of Attendance**" documentation for those who request it (to be excused from their school).
- **Please note:** These two days are the *only* days throughout the school year when outside or prospective students are able to attend classes because it can be disruptive to regular instruction.
